Providing Grants for Medical Treatment

**(1) FRANKIE'S FRIENDS** – [National Frankie's Friends Fund — Frankie's Friends \(frankiesfriends.org\)](http://frankiesfriends.org)

Applications for assistance will be considered if:

- Your pet needs emergency or specialty veterinary care
- Your pet has already been seen by a licensed veterinarian
- The veterinarian has determined your pet has a good prognosis with treatment
- You can show documentation of financial need
- And the treatment plan has not yet been paid as we do not reimburse for any payments already made

All grant applications must be returned with the following to be presented for consideration:

- Tax Return [copies only]
- Diagnosis & Prognosis, Estimate of cost
- Care Credit status (individuals must apply for care credit and submit evidence of either denial or approval with available balance)
- Telephone number that accepts calls from a "blocked" telephone number.

It is our requirement that all dogs we help be spayed/neutered prior to our providing financial assistance.

To be eligible for our program:

1. Your animal must need non-basic, non-urgent care only, and both you and your companion animal must meet our program criteria.
2. Your animal's medical needs must be able to wait the length of our current wait list, and;
3. You must contact us by email with your request prior to sending your application.

If you think your animal may be eligible for our program, email us at [info@thepetfund.com](mailto:info@thepetfund.com) with a description of your animal's medical needs. Include a phone number where you can be reached with your email as well. If your animal's medical needs match our program criteria, we will advise you to complete the application. \*\*\*Do not send the application before our staff has had the opportunity to review your email request for assistance.

**BEFORE YOU START**

- After you have been advised by The Pet Fund staff and it has been determined that you may be eligible to apply for funding, you will need to have the following items available to help you complete the financial portion of

the online application. We advise that you gather this information together before you begin your online application. **Once you have started the online application, you will not be able to return at a later time to complete it. You will have to start over from the beginning with your online application for funding.**

**If the staff member tells you to apply –be sure you have the following info before starting the application:**

**COLLECT THE FOLLOWING:**

- **Proof of income** - This can be a copy of a **check stub**, unemployment benefits, disability benefits, etc. The proof of income must be **recent**, and we cannot use tax forms for this purpose.
- **Copy of a written cost estimate for the needed procedures and/or treatment from your veterinarian.**
- **Name, address, and medical license number for your treating veterinarian.** This will be included on your online application form. If you do not have this information available, wait to fill out your online application until you have obtained this information.
